

Bumblebee Routine



For our younger babies in our bumblebee room we follow home routines and as they start to become older they start to fit into more of a set routine.

7:45	Good Morning	We say Good Morning to our babies and have breakfast if needed.
9:00	Snack Time	Toast and milk/water is available for all babies.
9:15	Free Play	Babies explore a variety of activities through continuous provision, sensory play and creative activities.
10:00	Nappy Time	We have a set nappy time unless a change is required before/after.
10:30	Outdoor Play	The babies love exploring in our garden, they have the access to water play, small climbing frames/slides, bricks, books and a range of other activities.
11:00	Free Play	Our babies have the opportunity to explore a wide range of toys, building, shape sorters, music, sensory. As well as providing messy activities for them.
11:30	Music & Movement	We provide music and movement times, story times and physical play where we can use tunnels, slides, rockers etc. Our babies love joining in with actions to songs and pointing to different objects in stories.
11:35	Lunch	Younger babies are placed in high chairs to eat their lunch and older babies sit in a group to the table. We encourage children to feed themselves and follow home routines such as baby led weaning.
12:15	Sleep/quiet Time	In our baby room we create a dusk and calming atmosphere with relaxing music to help children to settle into sleep.
2:00	PM Snack	A range of healthy snacks are provided.
2:15	Free Play	Babies explore a variety of activities through continuous provision, sensory play and creative activities.
2:30	Nappy Time	We have a set nappy time unless a change is required before/after
3:00	Outdoor Play	The babies love exploring in our garden, they have the access to water play, small climbing frames/slides, bricks, books and a range of other activities.
3:30	Music & Movement	We provide music and movement times, story times and physical play where we can use tunnels, slides, rockers etc. Our babies love joining in with actions to songs and pointing to different objects in stories.
3:45	Tea Time	Younger babies are placed in high chairs to eat tea and older babies sit in a group to the table. We encourage children to feed themselves and follow home routines such as baby led weaning.
4:20	Play / Home	Babies enjoy the last play of the day and say goodbye to all of our friends.
